This program is designed to facilitate the housing needs of moderate and middle-income households. Residence at **Flats at Mount Zion** requires that applicants meet certain qualifying standards established by the government. This program qualification is not connected with Section 8, however, housing choice voucher holders are encouraged to apply. Residency at **Flats at Mount Zion** is limited to those households having moderate incomes.
